He has worked on different tunnel projects in different countries, such as Ireland, Belgium, and the Netherlands, since 2009. This includes independent safety audits on design and 'ready to operate' certificates, investigated tunnel accidents, and prepared fire fighting training, operator control room training, and maintenance training. He has also been a member of the World Road Association (Working group on tunnel safety). For the last 6 years, he is heavily invested in tunnel maintenance and large-scale renovation works.
